Mark Taylor fighting for local bus services

The number 12 bus route is under threat from Conservative County Council cuts.

Brighton Hill North Labour Councillor Mark Taylor says "I oppose these cuts which will deprive our community of a local bus service that people rely on. Labour Councillors are campaigning to keep the number 12 bus."

Residents tell us that they rely on this bus service to get to work, to get to school and college, to get to the shops, to go to town, to see friends and family. It will isolate so many people if they lose this bus service.

Basingstoke is Hampshire's largest town, we are told we are thriving, expanding and a place where people want to live, but our bus services are not good enough.

The Conservatives either don't care or understand that their cuts will have such a dramatic impact on our community.

Stagecoach blame the Council, but it's our community that will lose out. It's your local Labour Councillors who oppose cuts to our local bus services. The clue is in the name, public transport.
